



The Call for Interest (CFI) has officially closed.

OVERVIEW AND TIMELINE OF THE CALL FOR INTEREST

H2med partners have officially opened their Call for Interest to assess the needs of future infrastructure users along the corridor.



The Call for Interest was launched in Madrid during a webinar with representatives from the five European TSOs involved in the project. Corridor promoters from each participating company presented the background of the process, detailing its main objectives and the technical steps for users on the platform.

Running from 7th November to 18th December, the H2med Call for Interest aims to identify needs across all the areas covered by the Corridor, in particular the national hydrogen backbones that the five project promoters are aiming to build by 2030 in Portugal, Spain, France and Germany.

The operators, who have previously carried out national or local consultations, are looking to update their understanding of the market's needs from now until 2050. Interested stakeholders are invited to take part in this process by submitting their input via the dedicated platform. We welcome all feedback regarding the

consumption, production and/or marketing of renewable hydrogen along the H2med corridor.

The results will be shared with stakeholders in the first quarter of 2025. This initiative will enable the H2med team to optimize the design of the hydrogen infrastructure and better meet the needs of local players and communities.
